Café Partage is a non-profit organization in Lachute that **every two weeks** on a **Tuesday**, delivers to Harrington – Harrington Golden Age and the Lost River Community Centre, fresh fruit and vegetables. This service is available to everyone, there is no age requirement or income restriction. For delivery to the LRCC, there must be at least **5** orders.

Each time, the produce is purchased from local area producers and stores at a reduced price and that reduction is passed on to the participants. The fresh fruit and vegetables can be purchased in any of the following three sizes and the cost of the box is always the same.

Single box:	\$ 9.50
Double box:	\$14.00
Family box:	\$20.00

We do not know ahead of time what will be in the box and it changes each time. Under normal circumstances, people may exchange with each other, any fruit or vegetables they like or don't prefer. This is NOT possible right now because of COVID-19. Please note that it is not possible to return an item or to decide at the time of delivery that you no longer want to purchase it.

Ordering can be done for these boxes no later than the Thursday before the delivery week, i.e. For May 5th, your order needs to be in by Thursday April 30th. You can also re-order for the following delivery each time you pick-up your orders. It would then be necessary to let me know only if you wished to cancel. Please contact:

If you have ordered a box, we ask that you be at the center on time, or

make arrangements for your order to be picked-up on time. We will not be using the centers so there is no possibility of putting your order aside for pick-up at a later time.

Through Café Partage it is also possible to order some groceries, meat and dairy products, and some prepared frozen meals, most of which are big enough for 2.

The order forms are available through the above contacts. They can be filled in if downloaded on a computer, or printed copies are available. Ordering can also be done by calling Café Partage, no later than the Thursday before the next delivery date, i.e. For May 5th delivery, order by Thursday, April 30th. When your order is received, the final cost will be calculated by Café Partage and you will be notified of the amount.

Payment by cash, must be the exact amount and in a small baggie when the groceries are picked-up. For anyone familiar with *e-transfer* for payment of money owing, Café Partage accepts this form of payment. Please note that no matter what security question you choose, the security response must be "**partage**". For instructions on how to pay this way, please contact Deedy at the number on the reverse side.
