CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NUMBER 194-01-2021 AMENDING CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NUMBER 194-2012, AS AMENDED, IN ORDER TO MODIFY CERTAIN PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE TYPES OF FOUNDATIONS AUTHORIZED

WHEREAS the Municipality of the Township of Harrington adopted Construction By-

law number 194-2012 for all of its territory;

WHEREAS the Municipality of the Township of Harrington wishes to modify certain

provisions relating to the types of foundations authorized;

WHEREAS a copy of this By-law is given to the members of the municipal council in

accordance with the Municipal Code of Quebec (RLRQ, c. C-27.1);

WHEREAS a copy of the By-law is made available to the public for consultation at the

beginning of the sitting;

WHEREAS a notice of motion was given on April 12, 2021;

WHEREAS a written public consultation was held for a period of 15 days;

CONSEQUENTLY, the Municipality of the Township of Harrington decrees, by By-law number 194-01-2021 amending construction By-law number 194-2012, as amended, in order to modify certain provisions relating to the types of foundations authorized, as follows:

ARTICLE 1 The preamble of this By-law forms an integral part thereof as if they were reproduced here.

ARTICLE 2 Construction By-law number 194-2012, as amended, is amended by adding a new paragraph before the existing paragraph in Article 2.1.3: stilts and pillars, which new paragraph will read as follows:

Notwithstanding article 2.1.2, screw piles or pillars or on a slab on ground, are authorized for any extension or for any part of the main building whose area is less than 30% of the floor area of said main building consisting of a continuous monolithic concrete foundation cast in place under the following conditions:

- a) the plans have been designed and signed by an engineer, member of the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec;
- b) a soil study has been carried out prior to said plans, if applicable.

ARTICLE 3 ENTRY INTO FORCE:

The present By-law comes into force in accordance with the Law.
