
PUBLIC NOTICE

TO INTERESTED PARTIES ENTITLED TO SIGN A REQUEST TO PARTICIPATE IN A REFERENDUM

SECOND DRAFT BY-LAW # 358-2024 AMENDING ZONING BY-LAW NUMBER 192-2021

1) PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT AND REQUESTS TO PARTICIPATE IN A REFERENDUM.

Following the public consultation meeting held on June 4, 2024, the Municipal Council adopted a second draft by-law at the Council meeting of June 17, 2024, entitled: "By-law number 358-2024, amending Zoning By-law 192-2012 of the Municipality of the Township of Harrington, in order to add provisions relating to trailer storage and outdoor storage for a residential group use". The second draft by-law takes into account the comments sent to Council.

This second draft contains provisions that may be requested by interested persons in the zones concerned and in contiguous zones, so that a by-law containing them may be submitted for their approval in accordance with the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities.

The purpose of this draft by-law is to:

- Add provisions relating to trailer storage and outdoor storage for a residential group use

The request for participation may come from the entire territory of the Municipality of Harrington.

This amendment is an initiative of the Municipality of Harrington.

The purpose of such a request is to submit the by-law for approval by those persons entitled to vote in the zones concerned and in contiguous zones that have requested it.

2) CONDITIONS FOR VALID APPLICATIONS

To be valid, all requests must:

- Clearly indicate the provision to which it relates and the zone from which it originates.
- Be received at the municipal office, 2940 Route 327, Harrington, Quebec, J8G 2T1, no later than eight (8) days following publication of this notice, i.e. July 8, 2024.
- Be signed by at least twelve (12) interested persons in the zone from which it originates, or by at least a majority of them if the number of interested persons in the zone does not exceed twenty-one (21).

3) INTERESTED PERSONS: A qualified voter is any person who is not disqualified from voting and who meets the following conditions as of June 17, 2024:

- Be of full age, a Canadian citizen and not under curatorship, **and**
- Be domiciled in a zone from which an application may originate and have been domiciled in Quebec for at least six (6) months, **or**
- Have been, for at least twelve (12) months, the owner of an immovable or the occupant of a place of business, within the meaning of the Act respecting municipal taxation (R.L.R.Q., c. F-2.1), located in a zone from which an application may originate.

Additional conditions for undivided co-owners of an immovable and co-occupants of a place of business:
be designated, by means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of co-owners or co-occupants, as the person entitled to sign the application on their behalf.

Condition for exercising the right to sign an application by a legal entity: any legal entity must designate from among its members, directors or employees, by resolution, a person who, on June 17, 2024, is of full age and a Canadian citizen and who is not under curatorship.

4. **ABSENCE OF APPLICATIONS:** All provisions of the second draft that have not been the subject of a valid application may be included in a by-law that does not have to be approved by those eligible to vote.

5. **CONSULTATION OF THE DRAFT:** A copy of the second draft may be obtained free of charge at the Town Hall, located at 2940 route 327, during regular business hours.
