# Household waste

East side: every Monday except on public holidays  
West side: every Tuesday except on public holidays

Landfilling waste generates significant costs for the municipality, which results in higher taxes for you.

- It is strictly prohibited to place construction materials or bulky items in household waste. You must dispose of these items at the Ecocentre.
- Branches are accepted only if they are tied into small bundles.

## Door-to-door collections

- The bins must be placed at the roadside the evening before collection, after 7 PM.

## Public bins

- Please keep public bins and sites clean.
- The use of bags or sealed containers is mandatory.

## Large objects collection

- The collection is limited to small quantities for private residences.
- Construction materials are excluded.
- Items must be placed at the end of the driveway, away from the house.
- You must register, by the Thursday before collection, with Catherine Rowlands at 819-687-2122 ext. 3228.

# Recyclable materials

Every Wednesday except on public holidays



Recycling helps reduce costs for the municipality as well as your taxes.

## Containers

Flexible or rigid, containers can be made of paper, cardboard, glass, plastic or metal.

How to spot them: recyclable containers usually have a cap or lid.

### Exemples :

- Shampoo bottle
- Oil bottle
- Laundry soap container
- Sour cream container
- Etc.

## Packaging

Like containers, packaging items are made of paper, cardboard, plastic, glass or metal.

How to spot them: they're used to easily transport a product.

### Exemples :

- Egg carton
- Fruit basket
- Canned food
- Paper bag
- Etc.


## Printed Paper

These are papers and other fibres with texts, patterns or images can sometimes be found.

### Exemples :

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Lined or squared paper sheets
- Envelopes
- Etc.

# Organic materials



Composting plays an important role in protecting the environment.

### 1 Is it edible or part of something that is edible?

Raw, cooked, or spoiled: All meal preparation scraps and table leftovers in paper bags or loose only.

### 2 Is it paper or cardboard?

Paper or cardboard soiled by food or used to package food.

### 3 Is it garden waste?

Cut grass, dead leaves, garden bed residues, cones and needles from conifers, straw, hay, potting soil and compost, untreated wood chips, etc.

### 4 Other

Cold ashes, hair and feathers, natural corks, litter, wooden toothpicks, etc.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO PLASTIC BAGS IS ACCEPTED IN THE COMPOST BINS.

## HOURS

### January, February, and March:

Saturday from 8 AM to 4 PM

### April and May:

Friday and Saturday from 8 AM to 4 PM

### June, July, and August:

Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 8 AM to 4 PM

### September and October:

Friday and Saturday from 8 AM to 4 PM

### November and December:

Saturday from 8 AM to 4 PM

Free service reserved for residents of the Township of Harrington. Proof of residence required.

### Authorized access:

- Automobiles
- Automobiles with small trailers
- Minivans and pickup trucks

### Prohibited access:

- Commercial vehicles
- Construction contractors and industries
- Trailers wider than 6' or longer than 10'
- Dump trailers and bin trailers
- 6, 10, and 12-wheel trucks

### Authorized materials:

- Construction materials
- Electrical and electronic appliances
- Metals
- Tires (without rims)
- Oils
- Old propane tanks
- Paint
- Dangerous household residue (DHR)
- Branches and trees (with a maximum diameter of 6 inches and a maximum length of 8 feet, placed in the same direction)

The total volume per trip must fit within a trailer measuring 4' in width x 8' in length x 4' in height.
